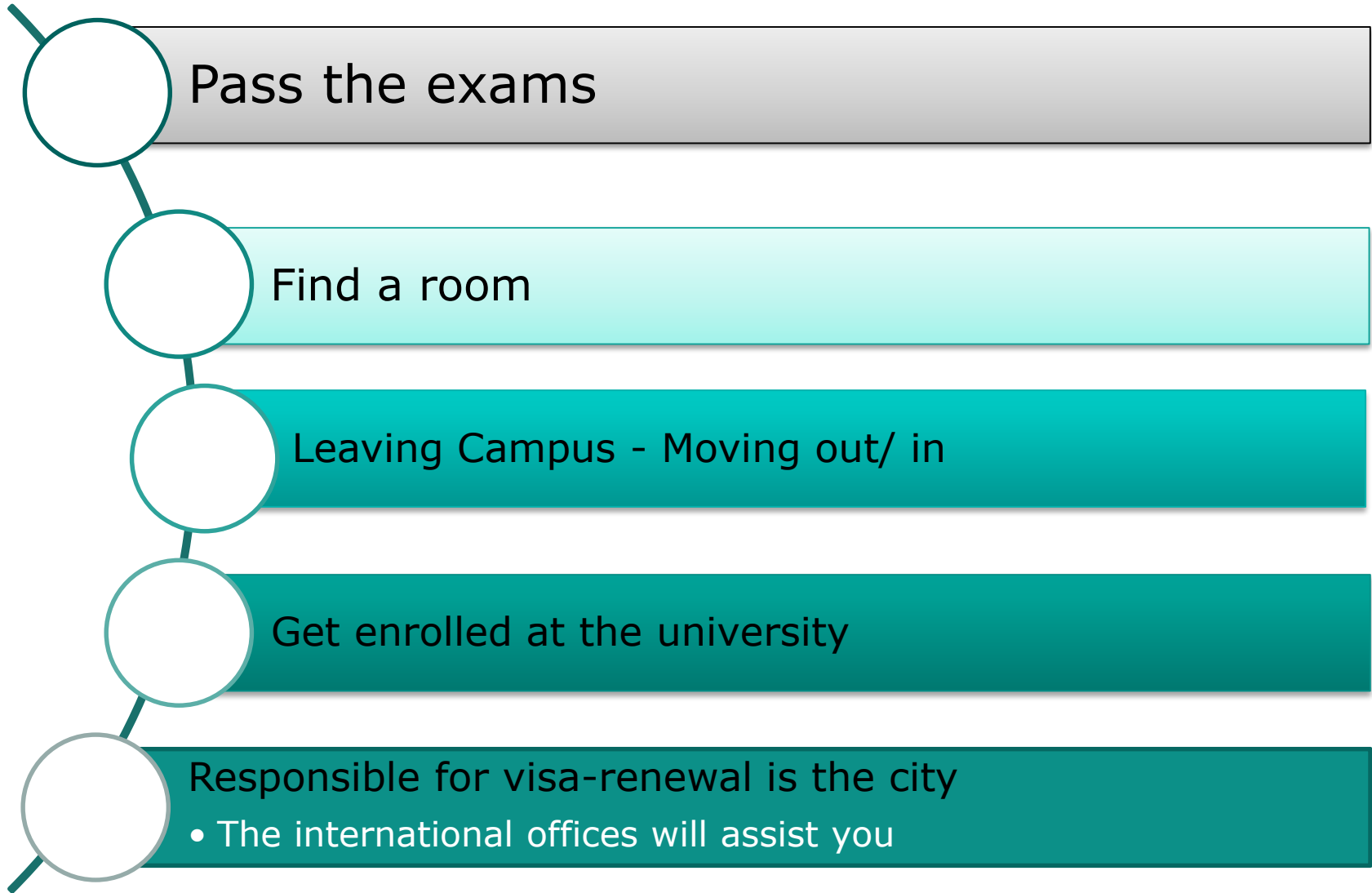

Apartments – Contracts

- Please be aware of the German contract law
- E.g. once signed, it is difficult to cancel any kind of contracts in Germany
- In case of insecurities or questions regarding the contract, please contact us

Important things for rent a room

Security deposit (*Kaution*):

- If nothing is damaged and everything is clean → get it back after moving out
- make an documentation of apartment condition with the landlord before moving in. (**Übergabe Protokoll**)

Rules for your house (*Hausordnung*):

- Quiet Hours (usually from 22:00-7:00)
- Clean the hall regularly
- Take out the garbage to the street
- Shovel snow
- Might have to renovate the room by moving out (wallpaper, paint, etc.)

Commission for agencies / Provision für Mieter

If an apartment is offered by an agency, additional costs to the rent and the deposit can be asked for:

Kaution oder Genossenschaftsanteile:	2 Kaltmieten
Provision für Mieter:	1,79 Kaltmieten incl. Mwst

Die Provision ist vom Mieter zu zahlen, fällig nach Untrzeichnung des Mietvertrages.

In the above example you have to pay the fee.

Furnished vs. Unfurnished

Most apartments and rooms in Germany are **UNFURNISHED**.
This means NO kitchens, beds, lamps, shelves, tables, etc.

Furniture to buy:

- Second hand furniture
- Shops such as IKEA, Tedox



What is a WG? Wohngemeinschaft (Flat sharing community)

a small group together in one flat.

You have to be considerate of the other people in your flat –

- cook together
- clean together
- party together
- be quiet when someone needs to study or sleep and
- be their friend

You share not only your kitchen and bathroom, but also your life!-

Treat other as you want to be treated!

How do I read the ads in the newspaper and on the internet ?

Zi (Zimmer)	room(s)

DG (Dachgeschoss)	top floor apartment
EG (Erdgeschoss)	ground floor
Wfl. (Wohnfläche)	living space (usually m ²)
qm (Quadratmeter)	square meters

Nachmieter	next tenant
K (Kaution)	deposit (up to 3 MM)
WM (Warmmiete)	rent including costs for heating
KM (Kaltmiete)	rent doesn't include heat, water, electricity and waste disposal plus extra
zzgl. NK	cancellation period. A written notice three months in advance
Kündigungsfrist	commission
Prov.(Provision)	
NR(Nichtraucher)	no smoking allowed
ZH(Zentralheizung)	central Heating
AR(Abstellraum)	storeroom
EBK(Einbauküche)	built-in kitchen
KN(Kochnische)	kitchenette
Balk.(Balkon)	balcony

- + 2MM Kaution, Garage möglich, Prov. frei

First month`s rent	425 euros
NK (Nebenkosten) – first month	150
2 MM Kaution – security deposit	<u>850</u>
	1425 euros

So you have to pay 1425 euros before your new landlord will give you the key.

Plus buy furniture, etc.

Unlimited Contracts

In case of moving out:

- Inform the landlord **three months ahead of time** by writing a **letter with your signature**
- By German rental law this cancellation period (***Kündigungsfrist***) is usually 3 months – **even if it is not written in your contract.**
- Registered letter (***Einschreiben***) is better since You will then have written proof that the landlord got the letter.
- Read your contract for the **cancelling restrictions.**
For example: some contracts only let you cancel at the end of the month.
- If you don't cancel your contract correctly, you might have to pay rent on 2 rooms at the same time.

Limited Time Contracts

- Cannot cancel this contract before the end of the **rental period!**
- Please be very careful before signing limited contracts!
- Some landlords might accept a 1 month cancellation period if you find next tenant (*Nachmieter*).

Important things

Subletting (Untermieter)

In order to sub-let your room you must get written permission from the landlord.

If you live in a student dorm, you have to get **WRITTEN PERMISSION** from the

- Studentenwerk
- International Office
- Student dorm commission

If you do not follow this rule, neither of you will ever get a room in the student dorms again.

Moving out

All Freshmen students must check out their rooms from the campus by latest Thursday, **31. August 2017.**

you are strongly advised NOT to go home on holiday until you have found a place to live.

All students please find new living quarters!

Before You Leave the Campus

Check out!!

No check-out = no deposit return

- Your room will be checked by Freshman staff. Inform the office of your moving date and make an appointment → Avoid waiting time.
- Return the keys personally and sign a form with your correct bank details. → Otherwise your 500 euro deposit can not be paid back.

Check out: Monday – Friday, office hours

(even if you will leave on the weekend, give keys to office staff/Student helpers)

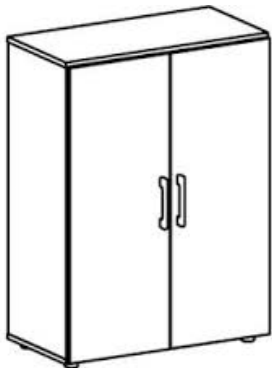
Before You Leave the Campus

Please check your rooms thoroughly and pack all of your clothes and personal belongings.

Clean your apartment!

You can keep your luggage in our luggage room.

A huge container will be filled with your garbage → in front of each house

Before You Leave the Campus

You can take sheets, blankets, pillows, bedcovers and pillowslips with you. The internet cables too.



All mattress covers have to be taken off the beds (white full mattress covers with the **zippers**).

The mattresses themselves must be left in the room.

Do not forget your clothing from the drying and washing rooms

Before You Leave the Campus

The kitchen must be left clean and tidy as you found it when you arrived at the Campus!!!

Remove ALL of your FOOD from the refrigerators and freezers.



All the cooking stoves and ovens must be thoroughly cleaned!

All of your kitchen utensils that you no longer need must be removed or thrown away.

Before You Leave the Campus

Return of your deposits:

- Return your **copy cards** to the office
- **Bicycles** – after checked and when in order

Return Math & Physics books, room key and the letter box key.

Before You Leave the Campus

- Your new address must be given to your bank, health insurance, and your cell phone provider
- Don't forget to change your delivery address (e.g. amazon, ebay)
- Your post can be forwarded to your new address by the Deutsche Post(Nachsendeantrag) → because no letters, packages etc. will be forwarded or collected without prior notice.
- **Empty your letter boxes.**



Deutsche Post - Nachsendeauftrag

You may have to pay a small fee for doing so:
19,90 € for 6 months and € 26.90 for 12 months (Only for letters).

Beauftragen Sie Ihren Nachsendeauftrag am besten 2 Wochen vor dem Umzug, mindestens aber 5 Werktage vorher. Bitte beachten Sie, dass nicht alle Sendungen nachgesandt werden können. **► Weitere Infos.**



Übrigens: auch in sensiblen Situationen können Sie sich auf den Nachsendeauftrag verlassen. Wenn zum Beispiel Briefsendungen aufgrund eines Sterbefalls oder eines Umzugs in ein Pflegeheim umzuleiten sind.

► Umzugshelfer

After you return from your home countries - after HOLIDAY

- Please note that your current student ID / Semesterticket is only **valid until 31. August 2017**
- After return from home countries, **you have to pay for using public transport** (U-Bahn, Zug, Bus etc.)
 - **Starting from 1. September 2017**
- If you use public transportation without paying the tickets, you will have to pay fines and eventually be criminally liable.

Health insurance is obligatory

- The fee will be automatically deducted from your bank account (appr. 80-90€ monthly) **after your registration in the University Duisburg.**
- Without health insurance, no registration at an university is possible!
- **Contact the insurance company and get the proof before 01.06.17**
- **Important:** always inform the health insurance about your new address!

This is to cover you, regarding any damage that may be caused by your own Neglect.

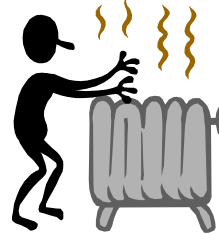
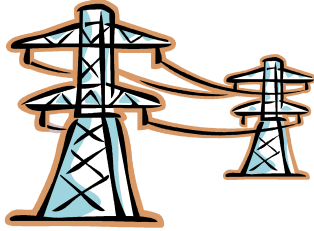
50-80€ pro year Huk24, Allianz, Debeka...

An example:

You have to notify the landlord if something is wrong (such as a leaky toilet) so he can fix it, otherwise if it causes more damage, you may be responsible.



Moving into the new apartment



- **Electricity, heat and water** are normally not included in the rent (Kaltmiete).
- Inform the appropriate provider, e.g. ([Wasserversorger](#), [Stadtwerke](#)) that you are the new tenant in your flat or room.
- Register with the **Rundfunkbeitrag** around 17,98/month in Germany (It is obligatory for every apartment), even if you do not watch TV or listen to the radio.

- Ask for help from landlord if you have any problems.

Moving to the new city

- Get registered in registration office in the new city immediately
(*Rathaus Einwohnermeldeamt* → *Ummeldung von Geilenkirchen*)
Without this procedure you cannot extend your visa
- Open new bank account (if necessary)
(*Ask for "Umzugsservice" in your new bank*)
- Inform your bank, health insurance company and your cell phone provider of your new address
- You can get the yellow bag for plastic garbage (Gelber Sack) in the city hall for free.

Enrollment

Get enrolled (immatrikuliert/Einschreibung) at the Uni Duisburg

The appointment will be

At the end of September or the beginning of October

**The exactly date and time will be announced!!
Don't miss this appointment!!**

Visa renewal

After getting enrolled in the University, within 4 weeks you need to renew your residence permit, no matter whether it is still valid or not!

Appointment from 'Ausländerbehörde' might be postponed to the January of the next year because of the huge amount of applicants, please

Start the procedure as early as possible!



What do you need for Visa renewal?

Please contact the international office/Akademische Auslandsamt for more information, normally you need to provide:

- Valid passport (residence permits cannot be extended beyond the expiration date of passport)
- rent contract/ Meldebescheinigung von Einwohnermeldeamt
- original student ID card for the current semester
- 1 passport-sized, biometric photo (taken in Germany)
- proof of health insurance – letter from the new health insurance.
- a **blocked account** of minimum **8,820€**. (**Sperrkonto**)
- 90€ (to be paid immediately when picking up your passport)



Blocked account / visa renewal:

Please Note:

A blocked account (Sperrkonto) is needed for your visa extension

- proof that financially you can support yourself for one year
- The Deutsche Bank and Commerzbank(Geilenkirchen) can provide such a service

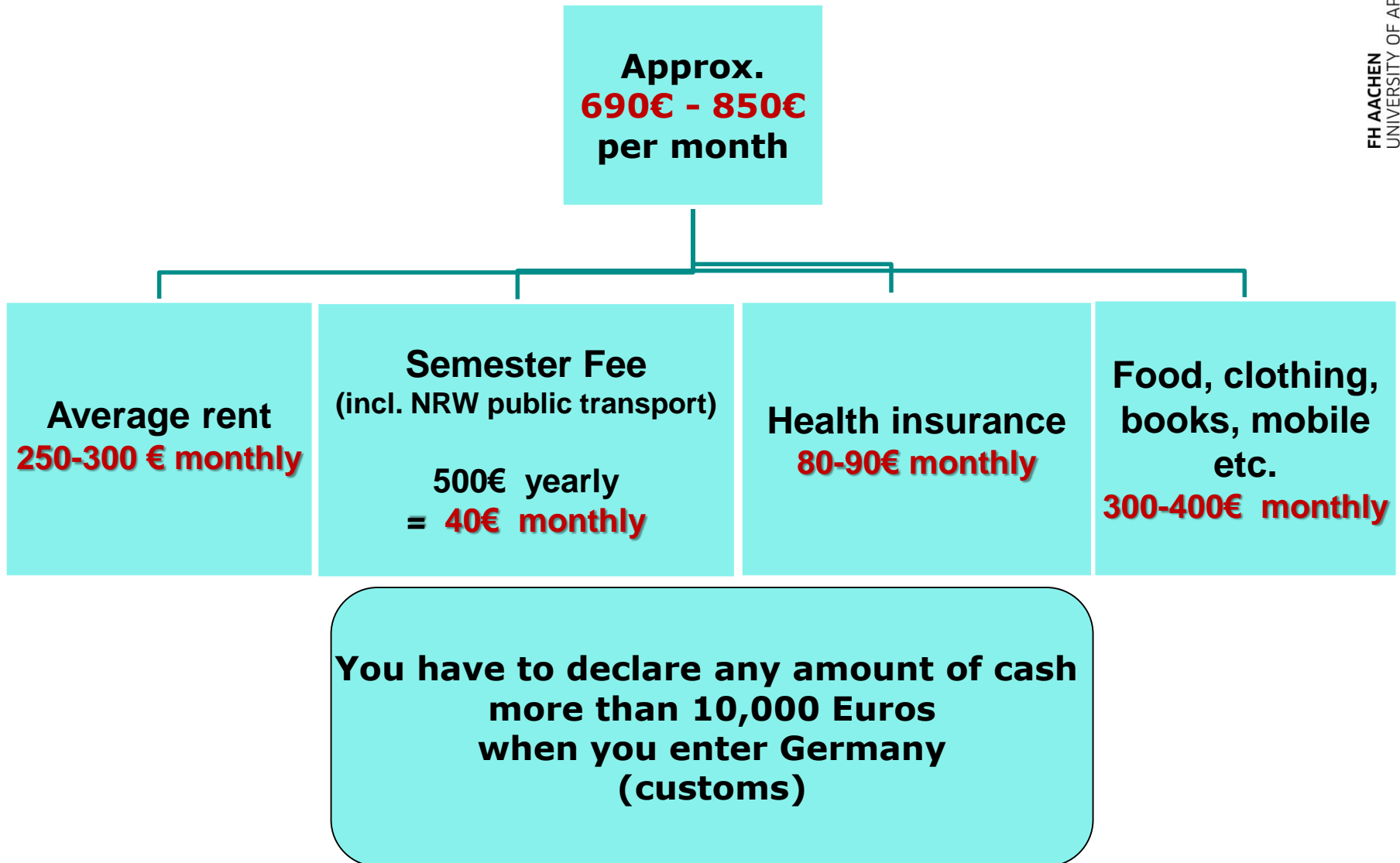
